Volunteer naturalist/trail educator: Teach/guide school groups that visit throughout the year. Training sessions are held regularly to provide information and guidance to prepare you for this program.

Butterfly House: (July-Aug.) Greet visitors, answer questions about butterflies and flowers, operate butterfly house bookstore, assist with gardening activities.

Maintenance: Outdoor tasks such as general trail maintenance, lawn care and building upkeep.

Gardening: May-Oct. Assist with care and upkeep of various theme gardens throughout the grounds.
